If you would like to build a career helping others, are detail-oriented and science-minded, the Hearing Instrument Technology program at Bates Technical College has much to offer you. This program is an Associate Degree program designed to provide graduates with both the instruction and hands-on practice necessary for completion of the required state licensure examination and professional employment. Typical completion time for most students is 18 months.

Program instruction includes:

- Hearing & hearing assessment
- Acoustics and sound
- Anatomy and physiology
- Hearing instruments, selection and fitting
- Psychosocial aspects of hearing loss
- Auditory disorders
- Instrument repair
- Hearing healthcare business

In addition to classroom instruction, our students gain hands-on, practical experience through work in the college's hearing clinic which is open to students, employees and the public.



Graduates of this program are trained to conduct hearing tests, counsel patients, make ear-mold impressions, and to fit, adjust and service hearing aids. Most graduates work in small and large hearing clinics selling and fitting hearing aids to patients, while others may work as audiometric technicians for physicians.
