This program is specifically designed to provide training to students of all skill levels, from those without any basic sewing experience to those with advanced knowledge and skills. Students prepare for a variety of positions within the fashion industry including alterationist, costume designer and construction, sewing instructor, and fabric store sales representative and manager. Instruction includes garment construction, pattern and garment alterations, textiles and their applications, specialty fashions, and fashion design. The program also provides extended learning opportunities for persons previously or currently employed in related professions. Prerequisite: A basic math test is required and a preferred COMPASS test result of Reading 80 and Writing 50.
