

## Fine Dining Provides Real-World Experience for Culinary Arts Students

Marinated shrimp, grilled sea scallops and stuffed lamb chops. That's what patrons of Bates' downtown campus fine dining service are feasting on.

Instructor Roger Knapp launched the service as part of the culinary arts career education program last June. This additional level of training will help set Bates' culinary students apart from others in this highly competitive field. "Introducing the fine dining experience allows our students to apply their skills in a restaurant environment," said Knapp. "This is their chance to be creative and develop menus, apply theory learned throughout the curriculum, and fine-tune techniques so they can extend their placement opportunities in a broader range of fine restaurants and hotels."

The dining service features an a la carte, made to order menu of items not available in the college's cafeteria. The Cascade Room offers patrons classic cuisine with a modern twist. Menu choices include starters such as stuffed artichoke; marinated shrimp; spring lettuce salad; and tomato with fresh mozzarella and basil oil. Sample entrées include grilled sea

scallops; stuffed lamb chop; wild salmon noisettes with ginger peach glaze; and sweet onion tart strip loin of beef with tomato horseradish emulsion.

An assortment of four delectable desserts will be offered, along with a selection of beverages and a soup du jour. Open to the general public, the dining room is located across from the cafeteria in the Cascade Room and is open Tuesday through Thursday, 11 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. The dining room seats approximately 30 customers. The average price of a three-course meal is just \$12.
