



## **Teacher Preparation Courses for Career and Technical Education Certification (Grades 9-12) and Professional-Technical Education Certification (Post-Secondary)**

Bates offers training that prepares individuals with business and industry experience for career and technical education (CTE) teaching careers at the secondary level, grades 9-12. Bates Technical College is approved by the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI) to offer this business and industry route to CTE teacher certification. Bates faculty may also take some of the courses to receive professional-technical education certification at the post-secondary level.

The quality, competency-based training is flexible making it easier for you to maintain jobs and family responsibilities while moving through the program. Courses are offered quarterly; weeknights, weekends; and some are offered via distance learning. An accelerated summer weekday offering provides an opportunity to complete the majority of your courses during the summer. You design your own plan to meet your individual needs.

Bates offers three different types of instructional delivery formats for the teacher preparation courses:

- Classroom:** The instruction is presented in a traditional face-to-face setting.
- Online:** The instruction is presented online using the BlackBoard delivery system and the internet. These courses require a login ID and password. When the course starts, you will receive directions about how to login to your course. Some online courses require a minimal amount of face-to-face meeting time. Check the schedule for required meeting dates.
- Videobased:** The instruction is presented on DVD or videotape and all course materials are mailed to you. You'll then have three months to complete the course.

<b>Philosophy of Career and Technical Education I</b>	Online w/meeting dates	12 hours	\$100	Explore the historical evolution of career and technical education and gain the foundational tools to create a model pathway program. Must be taken in conjunction with Philosophy of CTE II.
<b>Philosophy of Career and Technical Education II</b>	Online w/meeting dates	18 hours	\$150	Building on Philosophy of CTE I, explore and document your transition from business and industry professional to career and technical educator through a portfolio process. Must be taken in conjunction with Philosophy of CTE I.
<b>General Safety and Industrial Hygiene</b>	Online	6 hours	\$75	How to establish and maintain a safe working environment in which to teach as well as train students in safety and hygiene applicable to the industry.
<b>Methods of Teaching</b>	Classroom	30 hours	\$250	Learn tools and strategies for effective teaching in a career & technical education classroom or lab setting including facilitating and evaluating learning.
<b>Occupational Analysis</b>	Online w/meeting date	30 hours	\$250	Learn essential skills for performing an occupational analysis of a specific job and the basic skills needed for a competency-based curriculum.
<b>Course Organization</b>	Online w/meeting dates	30 hours	\$250	Provides essential skills for developing and organizing a course in a career and technical education setting.
<b>Student Development and Leadership Techniques</b>	Classroom	30 hours	\$250	Develop the knowledge, skills and information-base necessary to integrate student leadership activities into the classroom and/or operate a student leadership organization.
<b>Meeting the Diverse Needs of Students</b>	Online w/video component	30 hours	\$250	Focuses on the diverse needs of students in today's classrooms and a broad understanding of learning and behavior challenges.
<b>Coordination Techniques</b>	Classroom	30 hours	\$250	Learn to build a functional framework to coordinate a work-based learning program, and expand your knowledge to implement a diversified program.
<b>Introduction to School Law</b>	Videobased	3 credits	\$73	Basics of school law and how it applies to employees, students, and parents.
<b>Abuse and Neglect of Children</b>	Videobased	1 credit	\$22	Causes, extent, and dynamics of child abuse and neglect, and ideas for how it might be prevented or remedied.
